

# **Alumni King and Queen CONTEST**

## History of the Alumni Queen and King Contest

The National Alumni Association of Saint Augustine's College, Inc., Alumni Contest was initiated in 2003 as a means to generate money for its Annual Giving Campaign, while at the same time create friendly competition among chapters. Each chapter is asked to raise funds in support of an alumni queen (alumni king is now included\*) contestant. The winners are crowned during Homecoming festivities. In 2012, the College changed it name to Saint Augustine's University.

To date, this contest has been a successful endeavor, both monetarily and through encouraging school spirit.

\*On January 25, 2017, at a meeting of the officers on the National Alumni Association of Saint Augustine's University, Inc. (NAA) executive meeting, officers approved by acclamation that the contest be renamed Alumni Queen and King Contest (Now referred to as Alumni King and Queen Contest.)

## **Purpose**

NAA's King and Queen Contest is the major fund-raising event for the Association. The winners are the two Alumni representatives (King and Queen) with the highest amount of money raised through contributions and ads.

#### **Rules And Regulations**

Duties and Responsibilities of the NAA Officers and Contest/Coronation Committee

The Officers shall be responsible for the overall management of the Contest.

### **Duties and Responsibilities of Chapters**

A Chapter must be in GOOD STANDING for the current year in order to submit the names of contest representatives. GOOD STANDING means submitting a list of Officers & Members for the fiscal year in which a contestant is nominated for the contest.

All chapters are encouraged to have a designee to represent the chapter in the Alumni King and Queen Contest. If a chapter does not have a volunteer, it is recommended that the chapter without a representative support the contestant from a chapter of their choosing.

In addition, each chapter is expected to make a contribution to the homecoming fundraiser through the sell of not less than 50 (Suggested minimum is 75) raffle tickets.

# <u>Duties and Responsibilities of the Alumni King and Queen Contest/Coronation</u> Committee

Members of the Contest/Coronation Committee shall be the NAA Assistant Secretary; the current Alumni King and/or Queen); and the prior year's King and/or Queen; the Communications Manager (Website/Social Media); the 2015 Alumni Queen, and prior year's Chairman.

The duties of this committee will include, but not be limited to:

- Securing appropriate amenities as indicated by the "funds raised" levels
- Maintaining communication to ensure each contestant receives the necessary information to successfully participate in all activities during the Contest process from beginning to end.
- Monitoring winners during reign to provide assistance as needed.
- > Sending THANK YOU letters to all contestants for their participation.

# **Contestant Eligibility**

The Alumni King and Queen Contest is open to any graduate of Saint Augustine's College, now University, who is in good standing with their local chapter or as a Member-at-Large, and with the National Alumni Association. As of 2019, the contest is now open to individuals who attended Saint Augustine's College, now University, and are in good standing with a local chapter and the National Alumni Association.

The following are the good standing eligibility requirements:

- Local chapter:
  - Paid dues for current fiscal year in which the contest begins, July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, and
  - Paid dues for fiscal year in which the winner reigns, July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021

#### National Alumni Association:

- Paid Life Membership or Regular Membership for the current fiscal year
   July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, and
- Paid Life Membership or Regular Membership for the contest fiscal year
   July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021

Contestants must complete the NAA Alumni King/Queen Contestant Application and Biography Form for initial consideration during the fiscal year in which the contest begins. A Final Eligibility Form will be completed for fiscal year in which the winner reigns.

The Contest Committee will verify alumni King and Queen Contest applicants' eligibility and each person will be notified of their eligibility in writing.

The chapter that the contestant represents must be in good standing with the National Alumni Association for the current and upcoming contest year. A Chapter's good standing for the current year requires submitting a list of Officers & Members for the fiscal year in which a contestant is nominated and for the fiscal year in which the winner reigns.

## **Deadline Dates And Other Requirements**

Contestants must provide one color HEAD SHOT photograph, validation of membership dues paid, Entry Form and Biographical Data Sheet are due as indicated on Entry Forms.

ALL CONTRIBUTIONS FOR ALUMNI KING AND QUEEN CONTEST MUST BE RECEIVED AND REPORTED BY ESTABLISHED DEADLINES.

Contestants may begin campaigning upon notice that all pre-requirements have been met.

#### **Contributions**

Contributions will be credited to the contestants' total funds raised provided they are donated during the same fiscal year as the contest. Contestants will receive full credit for all monies that are received by the **National Alumni Association only**, prior to contest deadline **OF OCTOBER 9, 2020 12:00PM**.

Contestants or her/his representative will be given a receipt for total amount of funds received. If a check is returned to the Association unpaid, no credit will be allowed for that contribution. #### Winners Determined

The King and/or Queen contestant raising the largest sum of funds, and who meet the eligibility requirements will be determined to be the "Alumni King and/or the Alumni Queen".

Winners will be announced once all checks are cleared and officially documented by the NAA and ALL APPROPRIATE MONIES ARE COUNTED. Coronation will be held during the NAA-SAU Scholarship Gala.

The King/Queen Contest/Coronation Committee Chairman will notify the NAA President of the contest results. The NAA-SAU President will then call the winner (s) and the King/Queen Contest/Coronation Committee Chairman will call the runner-ups.
